To Whom It May Concern:

I contracted with California Green Designs of Encino ([www.ca-green.com](http://www.ca-green.com)) in the fall of 2003 to equip my house with photovoltaic (solar) panels. Since the house was undergoing an addition, Ca-Green could not begin work until the new roof had been installed. The roofing contractor ran very late and I became very worried that the panels could not be installed by the end of the year, possibly disqualifying me for the State of California rebate program. However, the roof was finally finished in December, and Ca-Green went to work. They ran into their own obstacle - an unforeseen shortage of invertors - but nonetheless, on December 31, the project was completed; the panels were online and generating electricity; and the job had been inspected and signed off on by all official agencies. I have nothing but positive feelings about the overall job, the personnel, the quality of the material and the quality of the installation. The system has performed without incident since it was installed and I would not hesitate to recommend California Green to any person considering solar technology for their home or business.
